Presented this 8th day of April 2024

WHEREAS, Rural Partners is a member-driven, not-for-profit organization created in 1989 and formally incorporated within the State of Illinois in 1993, to connect individuals, businesses, organizations, and communities with public and private resources to maximize the potential of rural Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, Rural Partners is a nonpartisan organization open to all, with member representation from federal, state, and local government, the private sector, and non-profit groups to collaboratively advance the growth and economic vitality of rural communities; and,

WHEREAS, for 35 years, Rural Partners has successfully encouraged and created such public and private sector collaboration to empower and build the capacity of the state and its rural communities by designating flexible and innovative responses to local community and economic development initiatives; and,


